

## Chapter Two

### QUICK FACTS

#### Introduction

Native Americans comprise less than one percent of the total United States population. However, in the last 10 years their numbers have increased by approximately 25%, as can be seen by comparing the estimated population for year 2000 shown on page 2.2 with the census figures for 1990 shown on page 2.3. Though they account for a relatively small segment of the population, Native Americans are a diverse demographic group. There are 550 federally recognized tribes, including 223 village groups in Alaska—and Native Americans live on and off reservations and in every state.

There is a large body of statistical data available through the United States Census Bureau and on the Internet; this chapter provides a glimpse into the demographic characteristics of the Native American population. On the following pages you will find statistics regarding the age and sex of Native Americans, the largest tribes, populations within states as well as populations on reservations and trust lands. Data regarding the number of Native-owned business is provided as well as a list of federally recognized tribes, categorized by federal circuit and district.
