A number of you have expressed concern regarding the length of time it takes for you to receive a bankruptcy notice or order in the mail. This court is offering a new way for you to receive notices and orders at no cost to you.

You may now choose to receive overnight bankruptcy notices/orders via Internet e-mail or transmittal as a fax to your office at no cost to you. Electronic noticing provides notices/orders days faster than the US Mail.

If you elect the Internet e-mail alternative, your e-mail provider must provide a return receipt to confirm the notice was properly delivered to your e-mail account. The notice is attached to the message as a file in Adobe's Portable Document Format (PDF). A free PDF reader plug-in is available from Adobe's web site, www.adobe.com. Call 888-502-5272.
